

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Carroll County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 1.83 percent. Continuing the current millage rate over the rollback millage rate would allow the Board to invest additional money in school safety, to purchase additional buses, and to have a balanced budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Carroll County Board of Education Board Room, 164 Independence Drive, Carrollton, Georgia 30116 on Thursday, August 9, 2018 at 12:00 p.m. Times of additional public hearings on this tax increase are Monday, August 13, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. and Thursday, August 16, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 17.998 mills, an increase of 0.324 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 17.674 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$125,000 is approximately \$14.90 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$12.96.
